Our primary intention is to provide culturally appropriate training with Métis teachers to increase the number of Métis creative arts practitioners helping Métis peoples in urban, rural, and Northern communities. There will be a limited number of spaces for non-Métis applicants working with Métis peoples.

We are curious about the ways your art-making, life experiences, personal and family stories, and hopes for the future may align with the intentions of our program.

In a **Personal Statement** of 500 - 1000 words, please reflect on the meaning of this program within your life, which may include reflections on the following:

- 1. A personal, family, ancestral, or community story related to Métis identity and the arts.
- 2. A reflection on your current use of the Creative Arts to contribute to the revitalization of Métis knowledges and communities.



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3. A discussion of your work experience and ways you feel this program could impact it and support the revitalization of Métis identity within your workplace

- 4. A reflection on your own or witnessed therapeutic use of the arts within Métis and/or other communities and what your key learning were.
- 5. A reflection on your use of the land as a teaching tool and ways this has amplified your understanding of yourself as a Métis person or ally.
- 6. If you are an ally, please indicate the ways in which you wish to use this program to amplify Métis voices and support the Indigenous resurgence

Secondary Application Materials

- 2. Current Resume, CV, or summary of prior experience. This may be communicated orally in the interview if you do not have one.
- 3. Documentation of previous experience in the arts. It is recommended your art portfolio include 10 pieces. This may include visual art, beadwork, personal arts practice such as a journal or poetry, photography, theatre script, videos of singing, dancing, theatre etc. Demonstrate that you are open to expressing yourself through the arts. Arts proficiency is not required or assessed, only your willingness to engage in creating.
- 4. \$100 Registration Fee (to be paid at time of application) Canadian and American participants will pay in their home currency. Participants from outside Canada and the United States are invited to contact WHEAT as program fees will be adjusted for residents from Category II and III Countries based on the Human Development Index.
